Experience Authentic Aboriginal Culture in the Heart of Stanley Park

“Klahowya” in Chinook (a trading language) means “Welcome” and that’s just what we intend to do. As you arrive to Klahowya Village in Stanley Park, you will be welcomed by an Aboriginal Tourism Cultural Tour Guide. The traditional welcome will honour the traditional shared territories of the Musqueam, Squamish and Tsleil-Waututh peoples and will include a welcome song. The tour is interactive – feel free to get involved, ask questions and take pictures!



Storytelling and Walking Tour

Your group will then be led on a walking tour through the forested area of the Village with your Cultural Tour Guide. You will learn about traditional foods and medicine, First Nations mythology, singing, drumming and legends.

Craft-making Workshop

Why not make your own unique souvenir to take home? As part of your tour, you will be invited to try your hand at Aboriginal craft. The Aboriginal artisan will take the time to explain Aboriginal craft and the traditional materials that were used and how they were harvested.

Live Cultural Performance

Enjoy a live Cultural Performance with Aboriginal dancers in their regalia, sharing the culture and traditions of their people.

Traditional Food Tasting

While you’re watching the live performance, you can sample some traditional Aboriginal cuisine. Try some fresh baked bannock with smoked salmon spread and Saskatoon berry jam.
